**BON JOVI lead guitarist, "Phil" Xenidis – better known as Phil X – is a Canadian musician and songwriter who grew up in Mississauga, Ontario.**

In 2011, Phil X substituted for Bon Jovi's guitarist Richie Sambora, and in 2016, Phil became an official member of Bon Jovi.

Bon Jovi is one of the biggest selling recording artists of all time and are currently in the middle of a world-wide concert tour.

Phil was featured guitarist for the band on their single, "*This House Is Not for Sale*" and album of the same name.

Phil X is also a prolific session guitarist, having played on albums by Tommy Lee, Methods of Mayhem, Avril Lavigne, Kelly Clarkson, Rob Zombie, Chris Daughtry, Alice Cooper, Thousand Foot Krutch and many others.



**Prakash John is a world renowned Rock And Roll Hall of Fame bass player and former Mississauga resident.**

Prakash was born in Mumbai India and moved to Toronto with his parents at the age of 13.

He has toured and recorded with some of the greatest artists of all time including Bush, Parliament Funkadelic (2 albums), Lou Reed (3 albums), Alice Cooper (3 albums), and his own band, The Lincolns.

In addition to the Lincolns, John is frequently in demand as a sideman for stars appearing in Canada & The United States. Acts he has worked with include Prince, James Brown, Paul Shaffer, Trailer Park Boys, Pinetop Perkins, Dr. John, Junior Wells and Mike Bloomfield. John also appeared in the film *Blues Brothers* 2000.

Prakash is currently working with his son, Verve recording artist, Jordan John.
